- The regular meeting of the Tennessee Region SCCA was called to order at 7:06 PM by Hayden
- Meeting was virtual due to Covid-19

### Regional Executive's Report [Hayden]

- Street Survival
  - On hold currently, possibly resuming in Q3 2021.
- Music City GP volunteering opportunity – Flaggers and other items. More info on previous meeting notes.
- 2020 Season Banquet – Cherokee Steakhouse in Gallatin, TN. Banquet hall, can do BBQ and has projector/screen to present awards. **Jan 30th 2021.**
  - \$20 per person or \$15 for kids 12 and under.
  - Please purchase tickets through MSR for all that are planning on eating.
  - Awards presentation to be streamed, will be on Facebook Live.
- Event Lotto
  - Winner randomly chosen at Banquet, but don't have to be present to win.
  - Currently have 10 tickets sold.

### Competition Director's Report [Logan]

- Championship jackets are currently being made. Should be no problem to have by banquet.
- Other awards are also in process, waiting on quote from shop but they said they can have them completed.
- Will renew 1 year of Axware timing – previously cost 350\$ for 2 years renewal.
- Next year schedule is currently being formulated.
  - Total of 10 points events planned
  - 5 NCM dates for Points events and 3 dates on Saturdays for non-points events
  - 3 JWAG dates (1 TnT, 2 PE)
  - Need April, June, and November dates still for PE. Current plan to use TFR for those three events. Was waiting for MCR to reply, but unfortunately none given. Will reach out to TFR about scheduling 3 dates. Could cancel TFR for another location if becomes available.

- Processing a \$1,930 credit – not applied yet
- Got new members onto the bank account. Treasurer [JB], RE [HP], CD [LA], and previous year (2020) ARE [JH] are on the account. Waiting for bank to send debit cards out to Treasurer, RE, and CD.
- Thanks to all the members and workers for what they've done the last couple years, increasing bank account for the last 2 years. First year since 2016 that we have \$20k in the bank.

  - LA got trailer registration in order to get a license plate. Will get after receiving credit cards.
